<p>English</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please continue to complete daily lessons via the BBC Bitesize website. These will include writing, reading and spelling tasks. • Please read, read, read! Nala has read all of the books in our school library. She needs your help to choose a new book. <i>Can you write a book review of your favourite book? Why do you like it? What was your favourite part? Would you read it again? What type of book is it? Who wrote it?</i> • Complete regular comprehension tasks. Activities can be provided on the Twinkl website. • Remember to practise your spelling, handwriting and letter formation. <p>PSHE</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remember that you are fabulous! Make a fabulous book and every day, write or draw something that shows how fabulous you are e.g. <i>I am a good friend, I am kind, I am good at football</i> etc... • Make a "Thank You" card for all the adults that have helped you to home school during this time.
<p>PE</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please access the daily 'Joe Wicks' workouts live on YouTube! • Cosmic Kids Yoga via YouTube. • You can also try completing the Daily Mile in your garden. How long does it take you to complete? Will you walk? Or will you jog?
<p>Science</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See Twinkl website for some home learning experiments! • Can you grow some vegetables or plants in the garden? (You must check with an adult first.) Then you could keep a plant diary about size, shape, how long it takes to grow etc... Remember it needs water and sunlight.

Geography 	Please complete a geography project about your local area. Are there any landmarks? Forests? Rivers? What is the weather like? Is there a school or church? Have a look on Google Earth to help you get started. (Ask an adult for permission first.)
 Art	This time complete a piece of artwork about the Titanic. This can be a drawing, a model, a sketch, a painting, a collage, a sculpture ...it's up to you!
