SCHOOL:

Bournmoor Primary School will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to Covid-19 and with the Local Authority risk assessment.
- Promote learning that is positive for your child's well-being, academic needs and mental health.
- Adhere to the social distancing rules.
- Contact parents if their child becomes unwell and follow the necessary steps if it is Covid-19 related.
- Inform you if a pupil/adult in your child's 'bubble' has tested positive for Covid-19 so you can self-isolate for the required time period.
- Continue our clear rewards and sanctions for children as set out in our Covid-19 amended Behaviour Policy (Covid-19 amendments have been added to ensure the well-being and safety of staff and pupils).
- Communicate between home and school via letters, texts, website and phone calls.



PARENTS:

To help my child at school I understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows signs of Covid-19 I will not send them to school, I will follow the government guidance on testing and isolation and I will keep school informed.
- I will inform school immediately of any changes to my contact details.
- If my child shows signs of Covid-19 at school I will collect them immediately (and any siblings), get my child tested and phone school to keep them informed.
- On my commute and when dropping/collecting my child I will adhere to the 2m social distancing rule.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly adhere to the school's timings and the information provided on how to do this safely (see our website for School Opening information on the home page).
- I will support school staff in their efforts to create a safe environment during this time by adhering to the information and guidance on the school website and that sent by letter or text.
- I will remind my child not to bring items to school or take items from school. They will not re-enter school at home time if they have forgotten something.
- I understand that to keep everyone safe I will communicate with school via email and telephone.



PUPIL:

I will do my best to:

- Follow the behaviour rules set out by adults in school to maintain the safety of myself and others.
- Listen to adults and follow instructions to ensure the safety and well-being of everyone.
- Enter and exit the school from the designated places.
- Wash my hands when I go into school and do this regularly for 20 seconds across the day as directed by adults.
- Follow the instructions from adults at playtime and lunchtime to ensure social distancing.
- Follow the 'bubble' rules that keep me safe.
- Not bring things into school or take things home from school and use the equipment I am given.
- Follow the catch it, kill it, bin it rule and sneeze and cough into my elbow.
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell.
