

What have we been up to this week?



This week we have been learning about birthdays as part of our topic, 'Let's Celebrate'. Our focus story this week is 'The Toys' Party' which is about a character called Kipper who has a party with his toys and makes a cake using tomato sauce, baked beans, milk, sugar, cornflakes and jam! We talked about how we celebrate birthdays in different ways, such as giving cards and presents, having parties and having a birthday cake! We read lots of other stories about birthdays such as 'Kipper's Birthday' and 'I Want a Party!'

In PE this week, we have been focusing on 'dance'. We explored moving in lots of different ways, linked to music. For example, we moved like different sea creatures to the song 'Under the Sea' from 'The Little Mermaid'! We also pretended to be 'Spiderman'! It was lots of fun.

As part of 'Road Safety Week', we read a story called 'Super Cat's Road Safety Story'. We talked about how to stay safe when we are around roads and learnt four key words: **STOP, LOOK, LISTEN, THINK!**
