


Area of learning	Activities:
<p>Literacy / Communication & Language</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read your reading book and any others you have at home. Focus on talking about the illustrations and handling the book carefully. Continue to practise recognising your name. You could even have a go at copying some of the letters! <p>Phonics – Focus on rhythm and rhyme</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete some of the rhyming home learning challenges from the sheet attached. Sing some Nursery Rhymes together. You can use the BBC School Radio website for ideas: https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/nursery-rhymes-songs-index/zhwdgwx <p>Focus story – Hairy Maclary Rumpus at the Vet by Lynley Dodd:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about the role of a vet. Talk about what you would like to be when you grow up. Draw a picture and talk about it. Watch the story, 'The Zoo Vet', https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7QNUoCvX9a8 Talk about what a 'Zoo Vet' is and the animals that they help. 
<p>Mathematics</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise counting aloud forwards and backwards up to 10. Sing some counting songs such as 'Five Little Speckled Frogs' and 'Five Little Men in a Flying Saucer'. You could access the BBC School Radio website for ideas - https://www.bbc.co.uk/programmes/p065s411 <p>Focusing on colour – White</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sing 'The Rainbow Song' to recap on the colours we have learnt so far - https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/nursery-rhymes-i-can-sing-a-rainbow/zn3tqp3 Listen to the story 'The Little White Owl' by Tracey Corderoy: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yw6xVdg0cQc Talk about the colours of the different owls in the story. Look around your house, and outside, for white items! Play 'I Spy..' using colours instead of letters, e.g. "I spy something white/green/red..."
<p>PSED</p> 	<p>Consolidate your understanding of 'feelings' in every day conversations. This could be when watching TV programmes or reading books, talk about how the characters are feeling and how you know this. Also talk about how you feel each day.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p> 	<p>Fine motor skills</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have some playdough at home, you could do dough disco to your favourite song. If you can't remember the moves, refresh your memory using this video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=i-lfzeG1aC4 Complete some of the fine motor skills suggested on the chart attached. <p>Gross motor skills</p> <p>Continue to practise different ways of moving including: skipping, hopping, jogging, running, jumping, shuffling, walking backwards, and any other ways you can think of!</p>
<p>Understanding the World & Expressive Arts and Design</p> 	<p>Make up your own pet and have a go at drawing it. Model some examples e.g. the head of a dog, body of a snake, hair of a lion, teeth of a crocodile, etc. Be as creative as you like!</p>

 <p>Who can make the best house for the three little pigs?</p>	 <p>Finger football!</p>	 <p>Who can fill the container the fastest using the pipettes?</p>	 <p>Following/creating patterns using spot stickers.</p>	 <p>How many sequins can you pick up (one by one) in 1 minute?</p>	 <p>Threading pipe cleaners on a colander.</p>	 <p>Counting out sequins to the numbers using tweezers.</p>
 <p>Save the animals from the swamp using the tweezers!</p>	 <p>Who can put the most elastic bands on the cup in 1 minute?</p>	 <p>Balancing marbles on golf tees using tweezers.</p>	 <p>Roll a dice, put that amount of cheerios onto your spaghetti - the first one to fill it is the winner.</p>	 <p>Save the insects from the spiders web using the tweezers!</p>	 <p>Cutting jelly with scissors.</p>	 <p>Making shapes on the geoboard using elastic/loom bands.</p>
