l

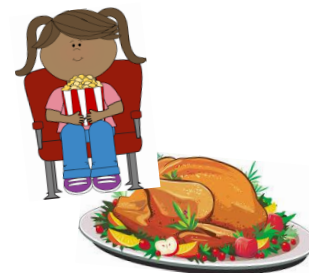
"Down the long leg"
