Wednesday	PSED	Children's mental health week	Today is 'Inside Out Day'! We are wearing something inside out today to remind us that we can't always see what someone feels on the inside, so we must always be kind. Talk about what it means to be kind. How are you feeling today? Here are some activities to help you to explore feelings: • 'Emotion Boogie' – Play some upbeat music such as 'I Love to Boogie' by Marc Bolan & T. Rex. Start dancing. When your grown up says 'Boogie happy!' you have to dance in this style. Think about how you can dance 'happy'. For example, you might have a smiley face, you might be jumping, etc. Start dancing again, and after 10 seconds listen to your grown up say 'Boogie' and another emotion such as sad, scared, angry, excited, surprised. Think about how you can express this emotion in your dance. • Design a t-shirt – You can use the template attached for this activity. Draw some feelings on your t-shirt – you can choose as many as you want. They can look like anything you want, only you need to know which feelings you have drawn.
