

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
	Spelling	Year 2 Common Exception Words	Practise these common exception words (CEW). Focus on the words: door, even, every, everybody, eye, fast, father, find and floor . Then put these words into sentences.
	History	Why is Elizabeth I important?	<p>Last week you researched Elizabeth I. Write down nine facts that you can remember e.g.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>She used to wear a wig.</i> • <i>When she was angry, she would throw a shoe at people!</i> • <i>She ruled for 45 years.</i> • <i>She could speak six languages.</i> <p>Then place these facts into a “diamond nine”. This is a way of showing what you think is the most important and what you think is the least important.
