

	Subject	Focus	Activity
Monday	Handwriting	Cursive letters	Practise cursive letter formation (robot letters: b h r m p n k). Please find a support sheet on Tapestry. Once you have formed the letters, please try to join the letters together if you are ready for a challenge.
	Maths	Divide by 2	Re-cap what division is by watching this video on the BBC Bitesize video: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zqbg87h/articles/z9jxhv4 Then complete the tasks on the White Rose home learning video. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Please find a supporting worksheet on Tapestry.
	English	Plan	Today we are going to start a story that will take us all week to complete, as we will write a paragraph each day. The paragraphs will be full of detail and brilliant vocabulary. First listen to Chapter 3 of The Sheep-Pig. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jDbRV4MBQas Babe is starting to explore the farm, so we are going to write a new adventure for Babe. What will happen to him? What will he find on the farm? Will he find something magical? Will he meet a monster? This is completely up to you – there are NO rules! Plan your story first using the headings: The Beginning, The Build Up, The Problem, The Resolution and The Ending. Write or draw your ideas.
	Reading	Comprehension	Complete “Making Lemonade” in your comprehension workbook (please see information below). Discuss the title, what type of text it is and what it is about. Remember to discuss the meaning of any unfamiliar words.
	Science	How should we plant seeds?	This week we will plan an investigation. We are going to think about what a seed needs to grow and test our ideas. Maybe you want to design an investigation where you try to grow seeds in different places? Or maybe you want to give some seeds water and don't give water to others? What about sunlight? Could you grow some plants in light places and others in dark places? Design your investigation. Remember to include a list of equipment . Then write your method (what you will do and how you will do it) and your prediction (what you think will happen). You can include drawings on your plan. 	Spelling	Year 2 Common Exception Words	Practise these common exception words (CEW). Focus on the words: gold, grass, great, half, hold, hour, improve, kind and last .
	History	When was Elizabeth I alive?	This week we are going to explore what life was like when Elizabeth I was alive. This is called Tudor times. What were the schools like? Did all children go to school? Were there toilets? What jobs did people have? What did the houses look like? What were they made of? How is it different to now? Write facts about Tudor life and draw pictures of Tudor times. 	Maths	Divide by 5	Complete the tasks on the White Rose home learning video. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Please find a supporting worksheet on Tapestry.
	English	Story	Today we will write paragraph two. This is called The Build Up . What happens next in your story? Is Babe going to travel somewhere? Has he found something? Remember to include lots of conjunctions, adjectives and noun phrases. Miss a line before you start writing your second paragraph.
	Reading	Word reading	Practise reading common exception words via the Tricky Word Trucks game.
