Then create a list of adjectives and noun phrases about the Iron Man. Next turn these into similes e.g. <i>His steps are as loud as thunder! The Iron Man is as gleaming as the sun!</i> Finally create a list of sounds words to describe his movements. This is called onomatopoeia e.g. <i>Crash! Bang! Stomp!</i>

	Art / DT	Roman Mosaics: Art	Printing your own coloured square tiles and using these to create a mosaic picture. Cut square shapes out of potatoes, carrots, sponges, etc, what ever you have at home. Use these square pieces to print different coloured paint squares on to separate pieces of paper/card that you can cut out when dry. These will become your mosaic tiles. Use your printed squares to create a mosaic picture on a new piece of paper.
