	Subject	Focus	Activity
Monday	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Can you have a go at clapping out the syllables in your name? For example, if your name was 'Ben' it would be one clap, but if it was 'Holl-y' it would be two claps, or even 'Jess-i-ca' would be three! You could upload a video to Tapestry to show us. Once you have mastered your name, you can try it for members of your family or items around the house.
	Reading	Focus Story of the Week: 'Dear Zoo' by Rod Campbell	This half term, our topic is 'We're Going to the Zoo' where we will be exploring stories about zoos and the different animals that we might find in them. This week, our focus story is 'Dear Zoo' by Rod Campbell. Listen to Miss Pigg reading it for today's 'Staff Story Time'. If you have this book at home, please use it to read along. Talk about which animal was your favourite and why.
	Maths	Number 4	Watch the Numberblocks episode for number four on BBC iPlayer: https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08d61cv/numberblocks-series-1-four Practise counting to 4 using your fingers.
	P. E	Movement to Music	Select one of the 'Oti's Boogie Beebies' episodes on BBC iPlayer to have a go at. Here is the link: https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episodes/m000jsds/otis-boogie-beebies
Tuesday	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Put some objects in a bag. Play 'pass the parcel' with someone in your house. Play some music and then pause it. Whoever has the bag when the music stops has to take an item out and say which letter sound it starts with. For example, 's' for spoon or 'c' for car.
	Understanding the World – Science / Mark-making	Finding out about animals	Select your favourite animal from our focus story, 'Dear Zoo'. Find out some facts about it. Think carefully about where you can find information. You could look in some information books, if you have any, or on the internet with a grown up. Can you draw a picture of it and talk about the facts that you found out? You could record a video of yourself saying some of the facts while holding your picture and upload it to Tapestry!
	Maths	Number 4	Go on a number 4 hunt! Can you find any in your house?
	Reading	Reading a story	At the end of your home learning day, read any stories you have at home, watch the 'staff story time' video on Tapestry, or read an e-book from one of the following websites: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> https://www.booktrust.org.uk/books-and-reading/have-some-fun/storybooks-and-games/ https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/ Free 'CBeebies Story Time' app
Wednesday	Physical Development	Getting ready	Can you practise getting ready? This includes things such as putting your own clothes on, putting your shoes on, zipping your coat up, etc.
	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Have a go at the 'Cake Bake' game on Phonics Play - https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/1/cake-bake You will find the log in details at the bottom of this sheet.

	Expressive Arts and Design	Animal masks	Make a mask of one of the animals from the story. Be as creative as you like! If you would like a template, go to www.twinkl.co.uk/share and type in the code: EP6579.
	Maths	Number 4	Select a toy from home and pretend it's their birthday – they are 4 today! Can you design a birthday card for them? Draw 4 items of your choosing on the front. You could draw 4 balloons, 4 cakes, 4 candles, etc. Don't forget to write your name inside!
	Reading	Reading a story	Please access a story to read from one of the websites/apps previously suggested at the end of your home learning day.
Thursday	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Have a go at 'The Zoo Vet: Animal Initial Sounds' activity on Twinkl. Work with a grown-up to say the letter and find the animal that starts with that sound. For example, if it was 't' it could be a t-tiger or a t-tortoise. For this activity, go to www.twinkl.co.uk/share and type in the code: EP6579.
	Maths	Number 4	Think about your toy whose birthday it was yesterday. Let's celebrate! Can you prepare a party for them? Can you count out 4 knives, forks, spoons, plates, bowls, etc. ready for the party?
	Expressive Arts & Design	Singing	Watch and join in with the 'Giant's castle episode on the Durham Music website - https://www.durhammusic.org.uk/giants-castle-tiny-tunes-tuesday-episode-6 Join in with the singing and copy the actions.
	Reading	Reading a story	Please access a story to read from one of the websites/apps previously suggested at the end of your home learning day.
Friday	Physical Development	Fine Motor Skills	Complete a 'Funky Fingers' activity from the list attached.
	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Listen to the rhyming story as part of today's 'Staff Story Time' on Tapestry, read by Miss Pigg.
	Maths	Number 4	Play 'I Spy Number 4' using the sheet attached and see what you can spot that represents number 4.
	Reading	Reading a story	Please access a story to read from one of the websites/apps previously suggested at the end of your home learning day.
