Monday	Phonics	New Phase 3 sound: 'ai'	Today's new sound is 'ai'. Please watch the 'Twinkl' lesson and join in - https://youtu.be/mQiYGq2f91s After the lesson, complete the activity on page 31 in your CGP phonics workbook.
	Writing	Name writing assessment	At the end of every half term, we complete a 'name writing' assessment to see the progress that the children are making with writing their names. Write your name independently without any help from an adult or copying the letters from your name card. Take a picture of it and upload it to Tapestry.
	Maths	Addition to 10 by 'Counting On'	See Tapestry for the PowerPoint lesson of Miss Pigg explaining how to add by 'counting on'. After this, please complete the 'Counting on up to 10 Addition Sheet'. You can access this resource by going to www.twinkl.co.uk/share and typing in the code: EP3607

Go to www.twinkl.co.uk/share and type in the code: EP2567
	PSED	Safer Internet Day	Today is 'Safer Internet Day'. Read the 'Smartie the Penguin Story' together with an adult. You will find this has been uploaded to Tapestry. After you have read the story, make a poster that we could use in school to help children to remember how to be safe online. You could include phrases from Smartie's song: "Before you tap and click, you need to stop and think... and tell someone!" Don't forget to use your phonics to sound talk any words that you want to write. For example, you would sound talk 'click' as 'c-l-i-ck'.
	Maths	Addition to 10 by 'Counting On'	Access the 'Counting On: Addition to 10' PowerPoint and use the number line to help you to 'count on'. After this, have a go at the 'Addition to 10 Number Line Activity Sheets'. You can either print the sheet and complete it, or work it out by counting along the number line and then recording the answer on a piece of paper. 	Expressive Arts & Design	Singing	<p>Watch and join in with the 'There's a spider' episode on the Durham Music website - https://www.durhammusic.org.uk/theres-a-spider-tiny-tunes-tuesday-early-years-episode-5 Join in with the singing and copy the actions. You could then sing it again and clap to the beat of the song.</p> <p>What other parts of the body might the spider crawl on? Can you make up your own verse? Can you change the words and use another animal or insect to sing in the song?</p>

You could use the template attached if you like.</p> <p>Here is an example of what you could write:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Draw round your hand. 2. Cut them out. 3. Stick them on top.

Thursday	Phonics	Phase 3 sound: 'ee'	<p>Recap on the sound, 'ee' using the BBC Bitesize video and complete the activities – https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zvq9bdm/articles/zn9q92p</p> <p>Go to www.phonicsplay.co.uk and use the log in details below. Have a go at either 'Buried Treasure', 'Dragon's Den' or 'Picnic on Pluto'. Select 'Phase 3' and then '+ee'.</p>
	Writing / Understanding the World	Chinese New Year story	<p>Watch the 'Chinese and Lunar New Year Story' on CBeebies - https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/chinese-new-year</p> <p>This year is the year of the Ox. Can you find out which animal represents the year that you were born? Miss Pigg's is the dog!</p> <p>Which was your favourite animal in the story? Draw a picture of it and write a sentence to say <i>why</i> it was your favourite. For example: 'The ox was strong.' Remember to use your phonic knowledge and capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.</p>
	Maths	Number bonds to 10	<p>Watch the number bonds to 10 song on YouTube: https://youtu.be/ID9tjBUiXs0</p> <p>Complete the 'Part Whole Number Bonds to 10' activity sheet. You can either print this sheet or draw and complete them on a plain piece of paper. You can download the sheet on www.twinkl.co.uk/share by typing in the code: EP3256</p>

	PSED	Value of the month – 'Honesty'	This month, our 'value of the month' is honesty. Talk about what it means to be 'honest'. It means <i>telling the truth</i> . Share the 'Stop Telling Fibs' story on Twinkl. 'Fib' is another word that some people use for a lie. While reading it, talk about whether the boy was lying or not. You can either download it as a PowerPoint or an eBook. To access these resources, go to www.twinkl.co.uk/share and type in the code: EP8039
	Reading	Reading a story	Please access a story to read from one of the websites/apps previously suggested at the end of your home learning day.
Friday	Phonics	Phonics Sound Assessment	Using the sheet attached, check which sounds your child knows. Point to each one in turn. If they can say it confidently, then tick/highlight/circle it. If they hesitate or are unsure, leave it blank. In the box underneath, make a note of the sounds that they were unsure of and need to practise. Upload a photograph of this to Tapestry.
	Writing	'Spelling test'	Complete a 'spelling test' with your grown up using these words: rain, sail, train, seed, sheep, green . Try to use your phonic knowledge to write them <u>independently</u> . CHALLENGE – Listen to your grown up say this sentence, ' <i>The queen runs in the rain.</i> ' Count how many words are in the sentence and then have a go at writing it. Remember to use your phonic knowledge to segment the sounds and don't forget finger spaces and full stops!
	Maths	Number bonds to 10	Test yourself on your knowledge of number bonds to 10 using the 'Jungle Maths' game on Twinkl Go. Then, have a go at the 'Find My Total' activity sheet. Again, you can either print out the sheet or simply make a list of what you could buy on some paper. To access these resources, go to www.twinkl.co.uk/share and type in the code: EP3256
