

Year 1 Home Learning planner - WC 1.3.21



Monday	Maths	Number Bonds to 10	This week we will recapping our knowledge before returning to school and starting a new topic. Please watch the ‘number bonds to 10’ song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ID9tjBUiXs0 then find the Jungle number bond game on www.twinkl.co.uk/share log in using the pin GH7603 , see if you can beat your top score.
	Phonics	Split digraphs o-e	Today’s sound is ‘o-e’. Please watch the ‘Phase 5 with Felix’ found in the link below. After the lesson, see if you can tell your adult any words you have learned today that have ‘o-e’ in it.
	English	Descriptive Writing	Can you make your own version of ‘Hey Diddle Diddle’ using adjectives to describe? Please find task and example on Tapestry.
	Reading	Independent reading	Follow the link www.twinkl.co.uk/share log in using the pin GH4687 , and have a try and read one of the e-books loaded on. At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see today’s ‘Staff Story’ read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.
	Handwriting	Letter Formation	A selection of letters have been picked out for letter formation practice. They will be shown on Tapestry, if you feel like you need to practice letter that have not been listed, please try these too.
Tuesday	Maths	Addition practice	On Tapestry you will find some addition sums, please encourage your child to using the magic counting hat method (e.g. 6+5 = 6 in your head and 5 on your fingers) if you do not have objects to count with.
	Phonics	Split digraphs u-e	Today’s sound is ‘u-e’. Please watch the ‘Phase 5 with Felix’ found in the link below. After the lesson, see if you can tell your adult any words you have learned today that have ‘u-e’ in it.
	English	Persuasive Poster	Listen to ‘The Adventures of The Dish and The Spoon’ being read. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TTV7u9YsUNk Listen carefully to the story. Design a poster encouraging people to come and see the Dish and the Spoon in their amazing show. Example of sentences can be found on Tapestry .
	Reading	Independent reading	Play a reading game on the Book Trust website. https://www.booktrust.org.uk/books-and-reading/have-some-fun/storybooks-and-games/ At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see today’s ‘Staff Story’ read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.
	Music	Singing	Watch and join in with the ‘Young Austrian’ episode on the Durham Music website - https://www.durhammusic.org.uk/a-young-austrian Join in with the singing and copy the actions.

Wednesday	Maths	Subtraction Practice	On Tapestry you will find some subtraction sums, please encourage your child to using the magic counting hat method (e.g. 6-5 = counting backwards, 6 in your head and 5 on your fingers) if you do not have objects to count with.
	Phonics	Split digraphs recap	Join Miss Hartley and Felix for a Phonics Game. Found on Tapestry , Miss Hartley will explain the games and rules to you.
	English	Wanted poster	Listen to 'The Adventures of The Dish and The Spoon' being read. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TTV7u9YsUNk Listen carefully to the story. Make a 'Wanted' poster for the characters in the Carving Knife Gang. Example found on Tapestry .
	Reading	Independent reading	Follow the link www.twinkl.co.uk/share log in using the pin GH4687 , and have a try and the '60 Second Reads' loaded on. Start with Phase 3 and work your way up to Phase 5 (if possible). At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see today's 'Staff Story' read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.
	Science	Seasonal Change	We are now in a new season and with a new season comes new weather conditions. Listen to the seasons song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8Zjpl6fgYSY THEN Please find and complete the worksheet on Tapestry .

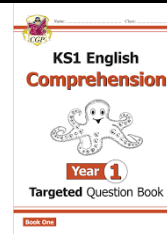
The below workbooks are what have been given to children to help their home learning.
