<b>Monday</b>	<b>Maths</b>	Count in 2s activity	White Rose Maths website– Home Learning Section. Please follow the teaching video and the find the worksheet on <a href="#">Tapestry</a> .
	<b>Phonics</b>	Split digraphs a-e	Today’s sound is ‘a-e’. Please watch the ‘ <a href="#">Phase 5 with Felix</a> ’ found in the link below. After the lesson, see if you can tell your adult any words you have learned today that have ‘a-e’ in it.
	<b>English</b>	New Class Novel	In school, we complete work focusing on a particular class novel. Our new book is ‘The Adventures of The Dish and Spoon’. Look at the front cover posted on <a href="#">Tapestry</a> Write sentences for what you can see on the cover. Examples posted on Tapestry.
	<b>Reading</b>	Independent reading	Follow the link <a href="http://www.twinkl.co.uk/share">www.twinkl.co.uk/share</a> log in using the pin <b>GH4687</b> , and have a try and read one of the e-books loaded on.  At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see todays ‘Staff Story’ read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.
	<b>History</b>	<b>Florence Nightingale</b>	<b>Say Hello to Florence Nightingale!</b> We are going to learn who she is and why she is a significant individual in History. Follow the link <a href="http://www.twinkl.co.uk/share">www.twinkl.co.uk/share</a> and log in using the pin <b>GH1502</b> , you will find a video of Florence and a matching worksheet all about her.
<b>Tuesday</b>	<b>Maths</b>	Count in 2s	White Rose Maths website– Home Learning Section. Please follow the teaching video and the find the worksheet in your workbooks.
	<b>Phonics</b>	Split digraphs e-e	Today’s sound is ‘e-e’. Please watch the ‘ <a href="#">Phase 5 with Felix</a> ’ found in the link below. After the lesson, see if you can tell your adult any words you have learned today that have ‘e-e’ in it.
	<b>English</b>	<b>Rhyming Words</b>	See a copy of the nursery rhyme ‘Hey Diddle Diddle’ on <a href="#">Tapestry</a> . Can you find the rhyming couplets in the nursery rhyme? After that, create your own rhyming couplets. For example: moon and spoon or dish and wish.
	<b>Reading</b>	Independent reading	Play a reading game on the Book Trust website. <a href="https://www.booktrust.org.uk/books-and-reading/have-some-fun/storybooks-and-games/">https://www.booktrust.org.uk/books-and-reading/have-some-fun/storybooks-and-games/</a> At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see todays ‘Staff Story’ read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.
	<b>RE</b>	Recap. So why is Jesus special to Christians?	Recap on what we have learnt about Jesus so far, in this unit. i.e., Jesus was special because of his miracles and because of his teaching about God. Recap the miracles by watching the following video. <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pKcTXDgt5il">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pKcTXDgt5il</a>  Draw a picture of Jesus and write words surrounding him that Christians use to describe him. They think he performs miracles, so you could use words like: <b>magic, amazing, a miracle worker or kind.</b>
<b>Wednesday</b>	<b>Maths</b>	Count in 5s activity	White Rose Maths website– Home Learning Section. Please follow the teaching video and the find the worksheet on <a href="#">Tapestry</a> .
	<b>Phonics</b>	Split digraphs	Today’s sound is ‘a-e’. Please watch the ‘ <a href="#">Phase 5 with Felix</a> ’ found in the link below. After the lesson, see if you can tell your adult any words you have learned today that have ‘a-e’ in it.

	English	Book Predictions	<p>Re-read 'Hey Diddle Diddle' from yesterday, explain to your child that the book is the story of the Dish and the Spoon after the nursery rhyme.</p> <p>Write sentences about what you think will happen in the book. Remember to use <b>and</b> and <b>because</b>.</p> <p>For example: <b><i>I think the Dish and Spoon will have an adventure because they ran away at the end of the nursery rhyme.</i></b></p>
	Reading	Independent reading	<p>Follow the link <a href="http://www.twinkl.co.uk/share">www.twinkl.co.uk/share</a> log in using the pin <b>GH4687</b>, and have a try and the '60 Second Reads' loaded on. Start with Phase 3 and work your way up to Phase 5 (if possible).</p> <p>At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see today's 'Staff Story' read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.</p>

	Phonics	Split digraphs recap so far	<p>'Phonics Splat' game with Miss Hartley and Felix</p> <p>Found on <a href="#">Tapestry</a>, Miss H will explain the games and rules to you.</p>
	English	Story Recall	<p>Listen to 'The Adventures of The Dish and The Spoon' being read.</p> <p><a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TTV7u9YsUNk">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TTV7u9YsUNk</a> Listen carefully to the story.</p> <p>Tell an adult what happened in the story, you could even retell the story to Miss H and add a video to <a href="#">Tapestry</a>.</p> <p>THEN - Ask an adult to test you on the following spelling: <b>spoon, moon, tricks, time, game.</b></p>


The below workbooks are what have been given to children to help their home learning.
