	Subject	Focus	Activity
Monday	Maths	One more one less	Please only complete the first sheet. It states you need cubes or counters, if these are not available to you, try using pasta, coins or sweets. White Rose Maths website– Home Learning Section. Please follow the teaching video and the find the worksheet in your workbooks.
	Phonics	Tricky Words	Watch the Phase 3 tricky words song and ask an adult to quiz you on how to spell each word in the song. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=R0871YrRpgY THEN Watch the Phase 4 Tricky Word song ready for English. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3NOzgR1ANc4
	English	Tricky Words	Recap on the song from the Phonics Session of Phase 4 Tricky Words. Can you write a sentence for each of the tricky words (said, have, like, come, some, what, when)
	Reading	Independent reading	https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/ Click ‘Browse e-books’ then ‘E-book library’. You can share any of the e-books together but, if you want your child to practise reading using their phonic knowledge, click on ages ‘5-6’ then on the drop-down menu that says ‘Levels’ then ‘Letters and Sounds Phase’ then ‘Phase 3’ or ‘Phase 4’ and it will give you a selection of books that they should be able to read themselves. At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see today’s ‘Staff Story’ read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.
Tuesday	Maths	One more one less	Please complete the second page of the work started yesterday. White Rose Maths website– Home Learning Section. Please follow the teaching video and the find the worksheet in your workbooks.
	Phonics	Phases recap	Follow the link www.twinkl.co.uk/share log in using the pin GH3746 , and play the ‘Phonics Pairs’ games loaded on. This is a recap of Phase 3, 4 and 5 sounds.
	English	Safer Internet Day	Today is ‘Safer Internet Day’. Read the ‘Traditional Tales, Internet Safety’ together with an adult. You will find this has been uploaded to Tapestry . After you have read the story, write a sentence for each of the characters giving them advice on what they should do next. For example, “Little Red Riding Hood should not go and meet Wolfie”.
	Reading	Independent reading	Play a reading game on the Book Trust website. https://www.booktrust.org.uk/books-and-reading/have-some-fun/storybooks-and-games/ At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see today’s ‘Staff Story’ read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.
	RE	Why did Jesus tell stories?	Jesus told special stories called parables. These are stories with a special meaning. The stories helped Christians to understand about God and how to live a good life. Read “The Lost Sheep” found on www.twinkl.co.uk/share and typing in the code: EP6347 Then discuss and ask questions like <i>What happened? How did they feel? How did the sheep feel? How might the sheep have felt when he was found? Was the sheep naughty? Have you ever done anything naughty or silly? Were you forgiven? Who do you think the shepherd is?</i> The message of the parable is that everyone is loved and forgiven.

Wednesday	Maths	Compare objects within 50	White Rose Maths website– Home Learning Section. Please follow the teaching video and the find the worksheet in your workbooks.
	Phonics	Phase 5 recap	Watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YPW-ZkhRUPY recapping the phase 5 sounds and see if you can recall the sounds you have learned so far. Then find on Tapestry another 'I spy and read' activity sheet.
	English	Drama	Today we are using drama skills, pretend you are a teacher. You need to teach your pupils (this could be real people or teddies) when they should use capital letters. Remind them capital letters are needed at the beginning of sentences, names, (places, people, days, countries) and I.
	Reading	Independent reading	Follow the link www.twinkl.co.uk/share log in using the pin GH4687 , and have a try and the '60 Second Reads' loaded on. Start with Phase 3 and work your way up to Phase 5 (if possible). At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see today's 'Staff Story' read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.
	Science	Reptiles and Mammals	Look at the PowerPoint found on Tapestry explaining what a Mammal is and what a Reptile is, the last slide explains the task.

	Phonics	Phonics Sound Assessment	Using the sheet posted to Tapestry, check which sounds your child knows. Point to each one in turn. If they can say it confidently, then tick/highlight/circle it. If they hesitate or are unsure, leave it blank. In the box underneath, make a note of the sounds that they were unsure of and need to practise. Please upload a photograph of this to Tapestry.
	English	Handwriting	Please copy the sentences found on Tapestry. This task is for focus on letter formation and writing on the line.

Choose a phase 3 comic, then a phase 4, then see if you can challenge yourself and read a phase 5 comic. At the end of your home learning day, log on to Tapestry to see today's 'Staff Story' read by either Miss Pigg, Miss Hartley or Mrs Kershaw.



