

	Subject	Focus	Activity
Monday	Handwriting	Cursive letters	Practise cursive letter formation of the tricky letters (q, f, g, j, b, d, z). Please find a support sheet on Tapestry if you need it. A sharp pencil will help you to form the letters correctly. Remember that practice makes perfect, so practise, practise, practise! If you feel ready for the next step, try to join letters together.
	Maths	Draw pictograms (2, 5 and 10) activity	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Then complete the corresponding activities in the White Rose maths booklet (pages 14 and 15).
	English	Instructions	Please watch the video first to recap the features of instructions. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zkcbksk7 Mrs Hogget has decided to bake a cake for the local fair. Can you help her and write some instructions? First you will need to think of what equipment and ingredients you need. Then think about how you will make the cake. What do you do first? Then what do you do next? You must make sure the instructions are in order. Remember to include bossy verbs e.g. Mix the ingredients. Pour the mixture. Please find a PowerPoint with voice recording on Tapestry to support this lesson.
	Reading	Comprehension and word reading	Please read for 15 minutes. This could be a book that you have at home, the "Staff Story Time" on Tapestry or a book from the Book Trust website. https://www.booktrust.org.uk/books-and-reading/have-some-fun/
	Science	Which seed will grow into the tallest plant?	Look at the information cards on Tapestry. Can you order the plants shortest to tallest? Use the information to make bar chart. (You can find an explanation of bar charts on this website: https://www.mathsisfun.com/data/bar-graphs.html) Don't forget to observe any seeds you planted if you were able to complete the investigation.
Tuesday	Times Tables	x2, x5 and x10 tables	Please log-on on to Times Table Rock Stars (the details are in your homework books), and complete 10 minutes of practice in the "Garage" section.
	Maths	Draw pictograms (2, 5 and 10)	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Then complete the corresponding activities in the White Rose maths booklet (pages 16 and 17).
	English	Letter - plan	Please listen to Chapter 6. (Please only watch up to 11.55.) https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=d1oFleqikRs Summarise what has happened in the chapter via a story or mind map. You can draw or write your ideas. Remember to include key points. This will be your plan to use for next lesson.
	Spelling	Year 2 Common Exception Words	Practise these common exception words (CEW). Focus on the words: parents, pass, past, path, people, plant, poor, pretty and prove . Then put these words into sentences either written or verbally.

	History	Which Queen should rule?	<p>What can you remember about Elizabeth I and Elizabeth II? Quickly write or draw your ideas. Was life the same for them? What was the same? What was different? How do you know? Why? Who do you think was the better ruler? Why?</p> <p>Write a persuasive argument explaining why your Elizabeth should be queen. You must give reasons to support your opinions.</p>
Wednesday	Times Tables	X2, x3, x 5 and x10 tables	Complete the times table race on Tapestry. Only spend 10 minutes on this. Draw arrays to help you. If you don't know an answer, please don't spend too long on this, just move on and go back to it.
	Maths	Interpret pictograms (2, 5 and 10)	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Then complete the corresponding activities in the White Rose maths booklet (pages 18 to 21).
	English	Letter	Using your plan from yesterday, please write a letter to me explaining what happened in Chapter 6 of The Sheep-Pig. Remember to include commas in a list, exclamation and question marks and adjectives.
	Reading	Comprehension	Complete "On the Farm" in your comprehension workbook (please see information below). Discuss the title, what type of text it is and what it is about. Remember to discuss the meaning of any unfamiliar words.
	RE	Why do Christians say sorry?	Watch the video of "The Lost Son" to understand why being sorry is important. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zsmpvcw What do you think sorry means? How do you show that you are sorry? Why is being sorry important? Please design a "sorry" card and explain why being sorry is important.

	Maths	Block diagrams	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Using sweets or coloured objects found in the house please create a block diagram (or bar chart). Count the sweets and update a tally chart. Then use these numbers to make a block diagram. Please find an attached worksheet on Tapestry to complete OR complete the corresponding activities in the White Rose maths booklet (pages 22 to 25).
	English	Email	Discuss what has happened in The Sheep-Pig so far. Who wrote it? Who are the characters? Who is your favourite character? Why? What is the best bit? What do you think will happen? Do you enjoy the story? Why? Create a spider diagram of all your ideas. Then write me an email (please note this is just the format) all about The Sheep-Pig.
