


Year 3/4 Home Learning planner - WC 01.03.21

Select 5 words from your spelling list and write a sentence for each one. Remember to use correct punctuation, adjectives, conjunctions, etc. to make your sentences more complex and interesting. Keep a record of your score out of 10 and any that were incorrect. Any incorrect ones need extra practice so you can spell them correctly. Complete the comprehension in CGP book. Remember to read the extract twice to understand what you are reading and then complete the questions. Keep checking the text to help you. It can be based on a game you already know (such as snakes and ladders, lotto, pairs, snap, shopping game, the fishing game, hungry hippos, ludo, operation etc) or a game you invent yourself. You will need to draw your design, label any parts, make a list of what you need to play it and write a set of instructions on how to play your game. You can make your game if you want to and play it with your family. It could be a type of card game, board game, maze, etc. You could use magnets (as he is made of iron!)
