	Subject	Focus	Activity
Monday	Handwriting	Joining	Last term we practised forming cursive letters. Now it is time to practise joining letters so we can write words. Please complete worksheets for letters “h, i, j and k” again as revision please. You can find this on Tapestry. Please complete these across the week.
	Maths	Unit Fractions - Revision	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Then make a game all about unit fractions. This could be Bingo, Snap or anything you like! You must include examples of unit fractions.
	English	Plan	This week you will write your own adventure about Babe. What will he do next? Plan your adventure using a story map or boxes. Each day write a different paragraph of the story. Try to write four paragraphs.
	Reading	Comprehension and word reading	Read a book of your own for twenty minutes. Is it fiction or non-fiction? How do you know? What is the book about? Why did you choose it? Would you recommend it? Why?
	Science	Can materials change shape?	Do you think materials can change shape? Collect together various materials. Then try to change their shape. Squish! Squash! Bend! Stretch! What do you notice? What happens? Do they change shape? Classify. How would you group them? Why? Compare. What is the same? What is different? Then write about your discoveries and observations. You may want to draw and label pictures too.
Tuesday	Times Tables	x2, x3, x5 and x10 tables and division facts	Please log-on on to Times Table Rock Stars (the details are in your homework book), and complete 15 minutes of practice in the “Jamming” section. You may want to go to the “Rock Slam” section and try Mrs Kershaw’s challenge!
	Maths	Non-Unit Fractions	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Create a poster explaining what non-unit fractions are. Please include examples, pictures and mathematical vocabulary.
	English	Paragraph one	It is time to write the first paragraph of your story. Include as much detail as you can. Try to include adjectives, noun phrases, similes, commas and exclamation marks. Remember to proof read and correct as you go.
	Spelling	Silent K	This week we will learn to read and spelling words that have a silent k but sound like n. Please learn to spell these words: knock, knife, knight, knot, knee, know, knowledge and kneel. Try to join!
	Geography	Can you plan a journey?	Design a map. This can be of anywhere that you want. Don’t forget to use co-ordinates on your grid. Then include symbols on your map of locations. Finally, describe a journey. You must remember to use locational language such as North, South etc...
Wednesday	Times Tables	x2, x3, x5 and x10 tables and division facts	Please log-on on to Times Table Rock Stars (the details are in your homework books), and complete 10 minutes of practice in the “Jamming” section. You may want to go to the “Rock Slam” section and try Mrs Kershaw’s challenge!


	Maths	Investigation	Please complete the Fair Feast Investigation. https://nrich.maths.org/2361/note
	English	Paragraph two	It is time to write the second paragraph of the story. Re-read your work from yesterday before you begin. Include as much detail as you can. Try to include adjectives, noun phrases, similes, commas and exclamation marks. Remember to proof read and correct as you go.
	Reading	Comprehension	Complete "Slippers at School" in your comprehension workbook (please see information below). Discuss the title, what type of text it is and what it is about. All of the answers are in the text – it is your job to find them. Remember to discuss the meaning of any unfamiliar words or underline important pieces of text.
	RE	When and Where was Buddha Born?	This week we will begin our new topic: What can we find out about Buddha? Please find out more about Buddha via this website: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zh4mrj6/articles/zdbvjhv Then complete your own rupa – you can make or draw this. Finally, write about Buddha's life. Please include where and when he was born.

	English	Paragraph three	It is time to write the third paragraph of the story. Re-read your work from yesterday before you begin. Include as much detail as you can. Try to include adjectives, noun phrases, similes, commas and exclamation marks. Remember to proof read and correct as you go.
	Art	Appraise sculptures	This week we will begin put new topic: sculptures. We will appraise the work of Andrew Goldsworthy. 
