

	Subject	Focus	Activity
<b>Monday</b>	Handwriting	Joining	Last term we practised forming cursive letters. Now it is time to practise joining letters so we can write words. Please complete worksheets for the letter "g". You can find this on Tapestry.
	Maths	Count edges on 3D shapes	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. <a href="https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/">https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/</a> Complete the worksheet on Tapestry – focus on <b>edges</b> . Then complete the counting edges activities on <i>Mathletics</i> . You may also want to complete the corresponding activities in the White Rose maths booklet if this is available.
	English	Comprehension	Please listen to Chapter 9 (up to 8.40). <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DVW2FkofO4s">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DVW2FkofO4s</a> Discuss what happened in these chapters. Was it a shock? What happened to Babe? How did Farmer Hogget behave? Write your opinions about them. What do you think will happen next? Why?

	Science	Can you describe the object?	This week we will begin to describe and classify different materials. First watch these videos all about the different types of materials. <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zrsgk7/resources/1">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zrsgk7/resources/1</a> Then collect a variety of different types of materials around the house. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Vocabulary.</b> How would you describe them? Write word cards to describe the different materials.</li> <li>• <b>Classify.</b> How would you group them? Why? What properties will you use? Size, shape, colour or texture?</li> <li>• <b>Compare.</b> What is the same? What is different? Write your ideas.</li> </ul>
<b>Tuesday</b>	Times Tables	x2, x3, x5 and x10 tables	Please log-on on to Times Table Rock Stars (the details are in your homework books), and complete 10 minutes of practice in the "Jamming" section. You may want to go to the "Rock Slam" section to try Mrs Kershaw's challenge!

	English	Spoken language	Please listen to Chapter 10 (from 8.40). <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DVW2FkofO4s">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DVW2FkofO4s</a> Babe must learn the secret password of the sheep. Your job is to perform this poem and to learn it off-by-heart like Babe has to. Remember to be clear, loud and include actions. Please find a copy of the poem on Tapestry.

	Spelling	Plurals	This week we will be learning to spell words that end in y, but the y changes to an i, and es is added when the word becomes a plural e.g. baby = babies. Please practise spelling these words: <b>spies, tries, flies, teddies, babies</b> and <b>berries</b> . Can you think of any other words that follow the rule? Can you put these words into sentences? Remember to learn the rule: change the y to an i and add es!
	Geography	What does that mean?	This week we will focus on vocabulary that we will use during the topic. These include: <b>compass, directions, north, south, east, west, map clockwise</b> and <b>anti-clockwise</b> . With an adult, complete some research to discover what the words mean. Then create a directions dictionary: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write the word.</li> <li>• Write the definition.</li> <li>• Draw a picture!</li> </ul>
Wednesday	Maths	Revision	Please complete "Autumn Term: Workout 6" in your KS1 Maths workbook. You have ten minutes! How many questions can you complete? The answers are in the back, please mark this and record your score on page 74. I bet your scores are improving!
	Maths	Sort 3D shapes	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. <a href="https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/">https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/</a> Using the 3D shape worksheet, please classify the 3D shapes using a Venn diagram. Will you sort them based on number of faces? Edges? 	English	Letter	Please listen to Chapter 11 (up to 7.10). <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Q4PvTelzoYQ">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Q4PvTelzoYQ</a> Using a story map, boxes or a bullet point list, write or draw what happened today. Then, using the information in your plan, write a letter from Fly to the rest of the farm animals about the events of the chapter. How does she feel? How does she think Babe will do? What is happening?
	Reading	Comprehension	Complete "The Tear Thief" in your comprehension workbook (please see information below). Discuss the title, what type of text it is and what it is about. All of the answers are in the text – it is your job to find them. Remember to discuss the meaning of any unfamiliar words or underline important pieces of text.
	RE	What can you remember about the Easter Story?	This week, we will continue to explore our new RE question: How do Christians celebrate Easter? Watch the video of the Easter Story: <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/religious-studies-ks1-the-christian-story-of-easter/zhgq47h">https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/religious-studies-ks1-the-christian-story-of-easter/zhgq47h</a> and draw a quick story map of events. Then continue to write a recount about the Easter story. Remember to include the key events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Palm Sunday</b> (The day Jesus came into Jerusalem and was cheered by the crowds.)</li> <li>• <b>Maudy Thursday</b> (Jesus' meal with his disciples.)</li> <li>• <b>Good Friday</b> (The day Jesus was crucified.)</li> <li>• <b>Easter Sunday</b> (Jesus came back to life.)</li> </ul>
