Once you have completed your plan, begin your email. Remember to include quotes from the characters, a variety of punctuation and write in paragraphs that link the information together.

	Art / DT	Structures	Use paper to make a mock up model of a Roman Catapult siege weapon. Roll pieces of paper in to tubes which makes the paper strong. Make 10 tubes, hole punch a hole at each end about 2cms from each end. Join the tubes by putting the tubes through the holes. Use an elastic band and a pot. See Tapestry for the instructions and diagram. Once it is assembled, test the catapult out by rolling up paper into balls.
