Remember to include the features of a letter, a variety of punctuation and write in paragraphs that link the information together.</p>

	Art / DT	Structures	Complete building your catapult siege weapon. Use paper to make a mock up model of a Roman Catapult siege weapon. Roll pieces of paper in to tubes which makes the paper strong. Make 10 tubes, hole punch a hole at each end about 2cms from each end. Join the tubes by putting the tubes through the holes. Use an elastic band and a pot. Once it is assembled, test the catapult out by rolling up paper into balls. Evaluate your model. What went well? How could you improve it? What would you do differently next time?
