Monday	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Play the ‘Sound story’ listening activity on BBC School Radio - https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/eyfs-listening-skills-sound-story/zhq792p Listen and join in.
	Writing	Name writing	Practise copying the letters from your name.
	Maths	Number 6	Practise counting to 6 using your fingers. Can you count out 6 objects?

Tuesday	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Listen to a grown-up read the story ‘Wake-Up Time on Bumble Farm’ on Twinkl. Can you hear the rhyming words? After you have read it, have a go at the ‘Bumble Farm Rhyming Words’ activity. You can find these resources on www.twinkl.co.uk/share by typing in the code: EP5086
	Physical Development	Fine Motor Skills	Have a go at one of the ‘Funky Fingers Challenges’ from the attached sheet.
	Maths	Number 6	Can you have a go at drawing 6 things? You could do it with chalk, paint, crayons – be as creative as you like!
	Expressive Arts and Design	Farm animal masks	Select your favourite animal from the story. Have a go at making an animal mask! Be as creative as you like.

Wednesday	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Sing some Nursery Rhymes. Use the BBC School Radio website for ideas - https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/nursery-rhymes-a-to-z-index/z4ddgwX
	Mark-making	Favourite part of the story, ‘What the Ladybird Heard’	Recap on our focus story from last week, ‘What the Ladybird Heard’ by Julia Donaldson. Using the pictures attached, put them into the correct order to retell the story. Which was your favourite part? Can you have a go at drawing it and talking about it?
	Maths	Number 6	Practise counting to 6. Think of different actions and practise doing 6 of each. Examples include: tap your head, pat your knees, clap your hands, etc. CHALLENGE – Can you make a pattern? For example, 6 claps, then 6 jumps, then 6 claps.
	P. E	Movement to Music	Search for ‘Cosmic Kids Yoga’ on YouTube and select one to have a go at.
	Reading	Reading a story	Please access a story to read from one of the websites/apps previously suggested at the end of your home learning day.

Thursday	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Play 'I Spy' using the sheet attached. Focus on the initial sound of the words e.g. <i>'I spy with my little eye, something beginning with sss'</i>
	Maths	Counting Skills	Practise your counting skills on the 'Gingerbread Man Game' on TopMarks - https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/gingerbread-man-game Select the 'Counting' then '1 to 5'. If you find this easy, move on to '1 to 10'.
	Expressive Arts & Design	Singing	Watch and join in with the 'Walking Through the Jungle' episode on the Durham Music website - https://www.durhammusic.org.uk/walking-through-the-jungle-tiny-tunesepisode-21 Join in with the song. March to the beat as you sing the song. Can you change the actions? Try jumping, stomping or skipping! Which other jungle animals could you sing about in the jungle?
	Reading	Reading a story	Please access a story to read from one of the websites/apps previously suggested at the end of your home learning day.
Friday	Phonics	Phase 1 – Listening Skills	Play a listening and drawing game with a grown-up. Take it in turns to sound out a word by saying the letter sounds and then the other person has to draw the item! Try the words sun, hat, ten, pan, box. So, for example, you might say <i>"Can you draw a h-a-t?"</i>
	Maths	Counting Skills	Sing some counting songs. You could use the BBC School Radio website to help you pick some - https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/nursery-rhymes-counting-songs/zn67kmm
	Reading	Reading a story	Please access a story to read from one of the websites/apps previously suggested at the end of your home learning day.
