	<b>Phonics</b>	Phase 5 ew	Today's sound is 'ew'. Please watch the ' <a href="#">Phase 5 with Felix</a> ' found in the link below. After the lesson, see if you can tell your adult any words you have learned today that have 'ew' in it.
	<b>English</b>	Using and	Using the sheet posted on <a href="#">Tapestry</a> , write a sentence about the two pictures, joining them with the word 'and'. Remember they must make sense alone and also together. <i>For example; I like cheese. Cheese strings are my favourite. Becomes... I like cheese <b>and</b> cheese strings are my favourite.</i>

	<b>English</b>	Using and	Using the sheet posted on <a href="#">Tapestry</a> , write a sentence using the sentence starters joining them with the word 'and'. Remember they must make sense alone and also together. <i>For example; School is my favourite..... Becomes... School is my favourite <b>and</b> English is the lesson I enjoy the most.</i>

	<b>Phonics</b>	Phase 5 oe	Today's sound is 'oe'. Please watch the ' <a href="#">Phase 5 with Felix</a> ' found in the link below. After the lesson, see if you can tell your adult any words you have learned today that have 'oe' in it.
	<b>English</b>	Mr Un	Follow the PowerPoint posted on <a href="#">Tapestry</a> all about Mr Un. When you are finished, see how many words you can remember from the story, write a list and ask an adult to check your spelling.
	<b>Reading</b>	Independent reading	Follow the link <a href="http://www.twinkl.co.uk/share">www.twinkl.co.uk/share</a> log in using the pin <b>GH4687</b> , and have a try and the '60 Second Reads' loaded on. Start with Phase 3 and work your way up to Phase 5 (if possible).



