Monday	Maths	Count in 2s	White Rose Maths website– Home Learning Section. Please follow the teaching video and the find the worksheet on Tapestry .
	Phonics	Phase 5 ey	Today's sound is 'ey'. Please watch the ' Phase 5 with Felix ' found in the link below. After the lesson, see if you can tell your adult any words you have learned today that have 'ey' in it.
	English	Asking questions	Looking at the front cover of our new class novel on Tapestry , write questions that you would like answered. <i>These could be.... What is the creatures name? Why is it sitting down? Why is the boat there?</i> Remember to start your sentences with a capital letter and end them with a ?
	Reading	Independent reading	Follow the link www.twinkl.co.uk/share log in using the pin GH4687 , and have a try and read one of the e-books loaded on.
	Science	Everyday materials	Look at the pictures shown on Tapestry , can you put them into groups of different materials. How did you group them? Plastic? Wood? Metal? Paper?

	Phonics	Phase 5 y	Today's sound is 'y'. Please watch the ' Phase 5 with Felix ' found in the link below. After the lesson, see if you can tell your adult any words you have learned today that have 'y' in it.
	English	Using adjectives	Look at our class novel front cover on Tapestry , write sentences using the adjectives, describing what you can see on the cover. <i>For example; The creature has white, pointy horns on its head. The blue water looks shiny.</i>
	Reading	Independent reading	Play a reading game on the Book Trust website. https://www.booktrust.org.uk/books-and-reading/have-some-fun/storybooks-and-games/
	Geography	Seaside study	Look at pictures of the seaside on your computer/tablet. Then discuss with an adult what you see. Can you label the: sea, sand, coast, etc. Which of these are man made and which are natural?
Wednesday	Maths	Count in 10s	White Rose Maths website– Home Learning Section. Please follow the teaching video and the find the worksheet on Tapestry .
	Phonics	Phase 5 recap so far	Please follow the instruction to the game/activity found on ' Tapestry ', recapping all of the phase 5 sounds we have learned so far.
	English	Synonyms	Search for 'Where The Wild Things Are' on Youtube and listen to the story. It keeps saying terrible – can you think of another word for terrible? Then – write some words that we could use instead of, happy, sad, big and little.
	Reading	Independent reading	Follow the link www.twinkl.co.uk/share log in using the pin GH4687 , and have a try and the '60 Second Reads' loaded on. Start with Phase 3 and work your way up to Phase 5 (if possible).
	Handwriting	Letter Formation	Look at the letters shown on Tapestry , can you practice your letter formation?



