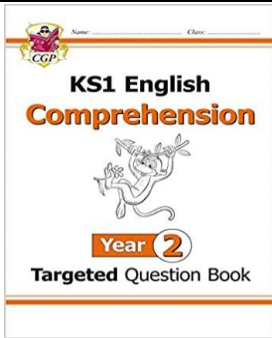

	Subject	Focus	Activity
Monday	Handwriting	Joining	Last term we practised forming cursive letters. Now it is time to practise joining letters so we can write words. Please complete worksheets for letter "i" again as revision please. You can find this on Tapestry. Please write words beginning with the letter k too.
	Maths	Non-unit fractions	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Create a poster explaining what non-unit fractions are. Please include examples, pictures and mathematical vocabulary.
	English	Research	Please research the author of Flat Stanley – Jeff Brown – and complete a spider diagram of your findings.
	Reading	Comprehension and word reading	Read a book of your own for twenty minutes. Is it fiction or non-fiction? How do you know? What is the book about? Why did you choose it? Would you recommend it? Why?
	Science	Can materials change shape?	This week we will continue to discuss and explore the properties of materials. Do you think materials can change shape? Collect together various materials. Then try to change their shape. Squish! Squash! Bend! Stretch! What do you notice? What happens? Do they change shape? Classify. How would you group them? Why? Compare. What is the same? What is different? Then write about your discoveries and observations. You may want to draw and label pictures too.

	Maths	Equivalence	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Complete the investigation: https://nrich.maths.org/4519
	English	Fact File	Using the information that you researched yesterday, please complete a fact file about Jeff Brown. Use conjunctions to extend your sentences. Try to start your sentences in different ways.
	Spelling	Silent K	This week we will learn to read and spelling words that have a silent k but sound like n. Please learn to spell these words: knock, knife, knight, knot, knee, know, knowledge and kneel. Try to join!
	Geography	What have you learnt during this topic?	This week we will assess our understanding of the topic. Pupils will complete the L of the KWL grid – what have you LEARNED? This can be presented any way that you like. Tell me everything that you know about maps, compasses and directions.

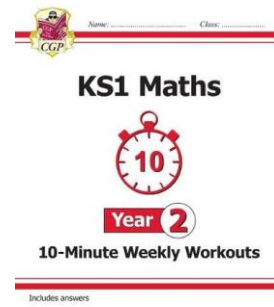
	Maths	Find three quarters	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Calculate $\frac{3}{4}$ of 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24 and 28 using division and multiplication skills.
	English	Letter	What would you like to ask Jeff Brown if you could? Create a list of questions to ask him – your fact file may help with this. Then write a letter to Jeff Brown. Remember to introduce yourself and tell him about yourself and our school. You may want to explain that we are going to be reading his book as our new class novel. Remember to include paragraphs, commas in lists and questions.
	Reading	Comprehension	Complete a comprehension of your choice from your comprehension workbook (please see information below). Discuss the title, what type of text it is and what it is about. All of the answers are in the text – it is your job to find them. Remember to discuss the meaning of any unfamiliar words or underline important pieces of text.
	RE	What can we learn from the story of Siddhartha and the Swan?	Re-cap what you can remember about Buddha. Then watch the story: https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/class-clips-video/religious-studies-ks1-the-buddhist-story-of-siddhartha-and-the-swan-and-the-monkey-king/zfkcwty Then write a persuasive argument explaining why it is important to care for animals. Remember to give evidence to support your opinions.
Thursday	Spelling	Common Exception Words	Practise these spellings. (These can be found in the back of your homework book.) Focus on the words: child, children, Christmas, class, climb, clothes, could, cold . Then put these into sentences.
	Maths	Counting in Fractions	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Practice counting forwards in halves, thirds and quarters.
	English	Themes	Using the sheet on Tapestry, analyse the pictures to discover what the themes of the novel may be. Please write down your ideas.
	Art	Sculptures	Last week we designed natural sculptures based on the artwork of Andy Goldsworthy. Now it is time to make them! Please complete your sculptures made from natural materials.
