
	Subject	Focus	Activity
Monday	Handwriting	Joining	Last term we practised forming cursive letters. Now it is time to practise joining letters so we can write words. Please complete worksheets for letter "n" again as revision please.
	Maths	Compare length and heights	Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ Select a variety of objects that can be found around the home and compare the length and height of the objects. Remember to use key vocabulary: shorter, taller and longer.
	English	Comprehension	Listen to chapter one. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9BOLxBKy4MM What is this chapter about? What happens? What are the names of the characters? Where is the book set? What do you think will happen next? Write down all of your thoughts and ideas.
	Reading	Comprehension and word reading	Read a book of your own for twenty minutes. Is it fiction or non-fiction? How do you know? What is the book about? Why did you choose it? Would you recommend it? Why?
	Science	How can we keep Babe dry?	Babe has a problem. The sheep have invited Babe for a sleep over but it is going to rain! Can you advise Babe which material is best to make a tent? Can you help him? Please PLAN, DO and REVIEW the investigation based on waterproof materials.

	Spelling	Suffix - ing	This week we will learn to read and spell words that end in y and have the suffix-ing added. Please practise spelling the words: copying, replying, marrying, flying, drying, crying, trying and carrying.
	History	Titanic – vocabulary lessons	This week we will start our new topic all about the Titanic. Before, we learn more about the famous ship, we need to understand the meaning of key words. Please research the meaning of these words: iceberg, Atlantic Ocean, vessel, survivors, disaster and lifeboat.

Estimate what you think the measurement may be first and then measure it accurately using a ruler. Don’t forget to write cm!
	English	Plan	Please plan a recount about a real trip to the doctors or dentists. Please plan using story maps, boxes or lists. Think about the journey to the doctors? What happened in the waiting room? How did you feel? What was the doctor’s room like?
	Reading	Comprehension	Complete a comprehension of your choice from your comprehension workbook (please see information below). Discuss the title, what type of text it is and what it is about. All of the answers are in the text – it is your job to find them. Remember to discuss the meaning of any unfamiliar words or underline important pieces of text.

Record your answers in metres and centimetres.
	English	Recount	Using your plan, please write your recount. Remember to include commas in lists, question marks and apostrophes.
	Art	Sculptures- Assessment	Last week we made natural sculptures based on the artwork of Andy Goldsworthy. Now it is time to self-assess your sculptures. What materials did you use? Why? What would you do differently next time? What did you like about your sculpture?

	PE	Rounders	**SAFETY: do NOT complete these activities without an adult present.** Develop your throwing and catching skills by throwing a ball into the air.


Try to clap before you catch it again. Can you clap two times? What about three? Keep practising!
