

Write these down and then compare these using these signs <=> Don't forget to write cm.



Why? What is enlightenment? <p>Then make a Bodhi Tree. Design your leaf and write your happy feelings on leaves.</p>

	Maths	Four operations with lengths	<p>Watch the White Rose home learning video and pause to complete any tasks. https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/</p> <p>Next challenge yourself by trying to write and answer your own word problems about length that include addition, subtraction, multiplication and division questions. E.g. Mrs Kershaw's pencil is 14cm long but it snaps in two! It now measures 8cm. How much was snapped off? Or Saffy's toy is 23cm and Nala's is 17cm. How long are both toys if they are put together?</p>
	English	Plan	Plan a diary entry about the lost ring. Using boxes, story map or a list. How do you feel? What happened? Who was there? Include as much detail as you can from the chapter.
	Science	What do I know about humans?	<p>What do you already know about humans? Do you know that they age? Can you name any body parts e.g. legs, head or arms? Do you know why we need bones? Write or draw your ideas. Then watch this video: https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/search?q=ks1+science</p> <p>Using this information complete a spider diagram about what you already know about humans. Then write me a letter explaining what you would like to find out about the topic.</p>
