


	Reading	Independent reading	Individual reading of a book, comic, e-book of your choosing for 20 minutes.
	Spelling	Practice your spellings	Spelling practice for this week ready for the test on Thursday. See list above.
	Science	Forces and magnets	Today's questions: How can we show and measure contact forces? Recap what a push and pull force is by using different everyday objects, identify which is which. Change the shape of materials by twisting, stretching squashing, squeezing etc. and identify the action as a push or pull. Make an object move/ move faster/slower/further and identify the size of the push or pull force. Introduce force arrows. Two people lean into each other, then hold hands and lean back to model pushes and pulls and describe balanced/unbalanced forces. Investigate: What happens to the distance an object can be moved when we increase the push force? Please find the science task on Tapestry to complete.



