What have we been learning?

This week we have been learning about Autumn and the Harvest Festival. We learnt what happens at Harvest time and what happens during a Harvest Festival. We talked about our favourite fruit and vegetables, and learnt about where they come from. Why don't you have a go at this at home? You could select a fruit or vegetable and find out some more information about where it comes from! You can upload what you find to Tapestry. We then painted pictures of our favourite fruit and vegetables.

We talked about what happens in Autumn and focused on the changes to the weather and environment. We then went on an Autumn walk and collected lots of objects such as leaves, conkers and pine cones.

We have also been focusing on our class rules. We talked about what a 'rule' is and how they are to keep us safe. Together we came up with some rules for our class and everyone agreed to try their best to follow them!

s a t p


In your child's book bag, you will find an envelope with some letter sounds flashcards. Each week we will add the sounds we have learnt for you to practise at home.
