









### Year 3 Home learning 1

<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p><b><u>Stone Age Boy</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We are reading Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura as our class novel so could you please create a mini project about the book.</li> <li>• Research the author Satoshi Kitamura.</li> <li>• Proof read to check that you have not made any mistakes and if there are improvements you can make so your writing is fabulous!</li> <li>• Practise common exception word spellings, Year2 spellings revision and Year 3 spellings. Lists can be found on the school website.</li> <li>• Read any books, comics, magazines you may have at home.</li> <li>• Handwriting practise and letter formation. Use the spelling lists for handwriting practise words.</li> </ul> <p><i>If children wish to keep up to date with our class novel, it can be purchased on Amazon kindle or at WHSmith's and Waterstones.</i></p>

<p><b>PE</b></p> 	<p><b><u>STAY ACTIVE</u></b></p> <p>When at home it is even more important to stay healthy and stay active!</p> <p>This week I would like you to focus on the “Stay active” aspect of this. I would like you to make up your own warm ups and an exercise routine that you could teach the class.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p><b><u>Rocks and soil</u></b></p> <p>This week we would like you to do some research. What can you find out about rocks? You can present the information in a format of your own choosing (power point, factual booklet with drawings/ pictures, poster etc.)</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p><b><u>Typing practise</u></b></p> <p>Being at home is the perfect time to work on your word processing skills. Use the computer to research information for the English task, Science task and History task. Then type the information and create a word document or power point.</p>
<p><b>History</b></p> 	<p><b><u>The Stone Age</u></b></p> <p>What can you find out about the Stone Age: homes, food, clothes, jobs, and changes that took place at this time.
