



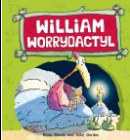

## What have we been learning?

### NURSERY

### RECEPTION



This week we have been focusing on composing and comparing numbers 1, 2 and 3. We have been exploring different ways of showing the numbers with our fingers, such as 1 finger on one hand and 2 fingers on the other hand makes 3 altogether! We have also been comparing amounts using the language 'more' and 'less' and have been exploring 'one more' and 'one less'.
