What have we been learning?

This week, Mrs Pinnington in our school office received a call from Santa! He asked if we could all write letters to him so that he can get organised for Christmas. We all thought carefully about what we wanted and wrote a letter with three items that we are wishing for. We were so impressed with the children's drawings and Reception even used their phonic knowledge to write a list and sentences!



We have also been talking about oral health and why it is important to keep our teeth clean. We talked about different ways to keep our teeth healthy including brushing them twice a day, going to the dentist regularly, eating fruit and vegetables, drinking milk and water, and not eating too many things with sugar in. We decided that our challenge is to practice brushing our teeth for 2 minutes twice a day – you could use a timer on your tablet or phone. We learnt a song called 'Brush Your Teeth' which is on the BBC School Radio website - <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/nursery-rhymes-brush-your-teeth/zv33hbk> This song is almost a minute long so if you play it twice you could always use this to time yourself, too!
