Subject	Activities:
<p>English</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are reading <i>The Great Kapok Tree</i> by Lynne Cherry as our class novel so could you please create a mini project about the book. You could research the author and find out about Lynne Cherry. Proof read to check that you have not made any mistakes and if there are improvements you can make so your writing is fabulous. Read any books, comics, magazines you may have at home. Handwriting practise and letter formation. Use spelling lists for handwriting practise words. <p><i>If children wish to keep up to date with our class novel, it can be purchased on Amazon kindle or at WHSmith's and Waterstones.</i></p>
<p>Mathematics</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete some Number and Place Value activities on <i>Mathletics</i>. Log in to Times Tables Rock Stars to practice times tables. Practice the 2x, 10x, 5x, 3x, 4x 8x, tables on paper in order and random questions. <p>Complete this week's activities on the WHITE ROSE HUB website – You can access a video for each session which includes explanations and tasks to complete – 1 video per day.
