


	<p>English</p>	<p>The Iron Man by Ted Hughes: descriptive writing – using pictures as a stimulus for your writing.</p> 	<p>You may remember that Ted Hughes wrote this famous book which has become a classic. Look at these pictures of the Iron Man character in Ted Hughes' story.</p>   <p>Brainstorm words and phrases that describe him on to a piece of paper. Think about what he looks like, sounds like, feels like, moves like and smells like. Remember to use adjectives, adverbs, similes, metaphors, alliteration.</p> <p>Use your brainstorm word bank to help you write a description of the Iron Man. Make you writing amazing by using correct punctuation, neat letter formation, use interesting words and sentences. Proof read to check and make improvements where necessary.</p>

	Science	Sound investigation: what materials are the best for muffling sound?	What is sound proofing? Watch this science clip about muffling sound. https://www.stem.org.uk/resources/elibrary/resource/32039/how-muffle-sound Investigate which materials are best for creating ear muffs. Collect some materials: paper, card, cotton wool, fabric (such as socks), kitchen roll, plastic, sponge. Make a prediction which will be the best for muffling sound and why, which will be the worst and why. Put some rice or pasta in a pot with a lid to make a simple shaker. Wrap the shaker in one of the materials and shake. Does it muffle the sound? Repeat with each different material. Order the materials from best to worst for muffling sound. Were you correct with your predictions? Draw a picture of the experiment and write a conclusion about what you have found out.
