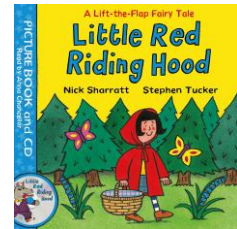

What have we been learning?

PHONICS

NURSERY

This week our Phonics focus was 'Police'. We enjoyed playing lots of listening games. We particularly enjoyed dressing up as police officers and being 'sound detectives' where we played a game where we had to listen to an instrument being played and then find the matching instrument in the classroom.
